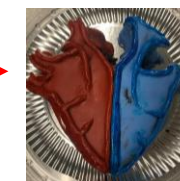

FURTHER INFORMATION - Economist

How much can I earn?

The average salary ranges from £28,000 - £60,000.

What it takes –

You'll need:

- Knowledge of maths, economics & accounting
- Analytical thinking skills
- Excellent written & verbal communication skills
- The ability to think clearly using logic & reasoning

Entry requirements –

You'll usually need 2 or 3 A levels, or equivalent, including maths & economics to study at University.

You'll usually need 4 or 5 GCSEs at grades 9 to 4 and A levels, or equivalent, for a degree apprenticeship.
