



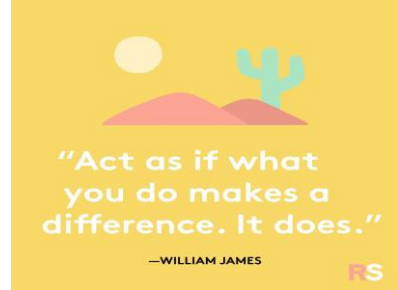

Kris Hellenga along with her twin sister, founded the *CoppaFee!* Breast cancer awareness charity, after a late diagnosis of cancer at the age of 23. Her work for the charity raised the profile of just how important self-checks are in both men and women. She won the Pride of Britain Award in 2009. Kris died in 2024, aged 38.

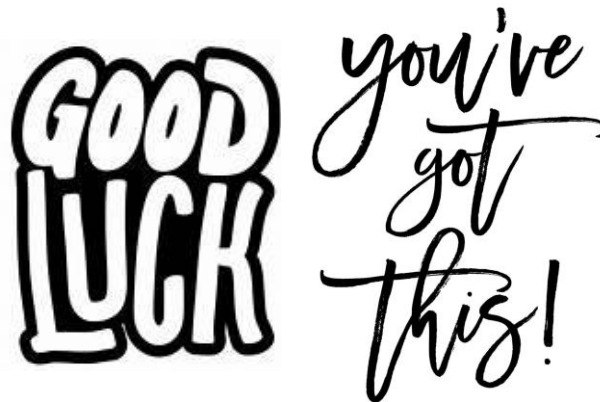
